Close to 2,000 youth have participated in these retreats since their inception, and we pray that you and your students will consider being a part of this year's experience.

We are pleased to offer Saints A.L.I.V.E.: *Confirmed for Mission* Confirmation Retreats three times during the upcoming academic year:

- Saturday, October 20, 2018 at Archbishop Wood High School, Warminster
- Saturday, February 16, 2019 at Pope John Paul II High School, Royersford.
- Saturday, March 23, 2019 at Msgr. Bonner / Abp. Prendergast High School, Drexel Hill

During these retreats, students will experience powerful talks, interaction with the seminarians from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, high energy music, games, and the opportunity to visit one of the Archdiocesan High Schools. A pizza lunch is included and we end the day with the Vigil Mass for Sunday.
